

2022 Stormwater Research Proposal Presentation Guidance and Instructions

Pre-proposals are required for all proposals. All researchers submitting pre-proposals are invited to submit full proposals.

Researchers submitting pre-proposals under Track 2 Discovery Projects are required to make a presentation to representatives of the Water Resources Center (WRC) and the [Minnesota Stormwater Research Council \(MSRC\) Advisory Board](#). This will allow you to gather input on your pre-proposal and incorporate ideas or clarifications as you prepare your full proposal. Track 1 Rapid Response Project applicants are not required to make a presentation. *Track 1 applicants may request a presentation and may be scheduled only if time and space allows.*

- Presentations will occur on Thursday and Friday, February 3rd and 4th from 8am to 12pm CST. A date, time slot, and Zoom join link will be scheduled and sent to you on Monday, January 31st.
- The main PI or another team member must make the presentation.
- You will have a total of 25 minutes allowing for 10-12 minutes of presentation and 10-12 minutes for questions to or input from WRC staff and members of the MSRC Advisory Board.
- Presentations will end sharply at the assigned end time. There is no going over.
- Presentations will be virtual through Zoom.
- Advisory Board members will have read your pre-proposal prior to your presentation. Given the short amount of time, you need not present everything in your pre-proposal.
- Highlight the justification (need) for the project, a brief, high-level overview of methods, anticipated results, usefulness or impact to stormwater professionals and communities and questions you may have.
- It is advisable to limit your number of slides.
- Center staff will provide a summary of discussion points and comments to the PIs following the presentations.
